
## What is ARGO Placements?

ARGO Placements is <u>a new tool for DFCS Staff</u> which is connected to SHINES and supports the placement process. It allows all DFCS Staff supporting the Placements process to:

- 1. Search for DFCS Homes, CPA Foster Homes, CCIs, ILPs, and TLPs for a child by matching the home's attributes to the child's needs prepopulated from SHINES
- 2. Create a Universal Application for any placement type by leveraging all available SHINES data

#### The key outputs are:

- 1. Weighted Search results showing placement locations that fit the need
- 2. Contact information for selected Placement locations available in Argo Placements and SHINES External Documentation
- 3. Shareable Universal Application available in Argo Placements and SHINES External Documentation





### What are the Objectives of ARGO Placements?

- Configurable Search to assist in finding available Placements and identifying the best locations that meet the child's needs
- Time Savings by having access to a targeted list of placement locations based on search criteria
- Flexible search for placements that match the need, regardless of bed availability
- Ability to search for placements considering sibling groups
- Enables Collaboration between all DFCS staff supporting a child's placement
- Reduced time needed to generate a Universal Application to DFCS policy standards
- Eliminates process redundancy by leveraging existing data to complete a search or a Universal Application


ARGO Placements is dependent on the current statuses of placements in SHINES

#### What will staff see? Search Results



Staff will be presented with a list of available placements available placements based on configured search criteria

Homes are scored based on location, school district, characteristics, and capacity

Users can drill into each location to review detailed information

### What will staff see? Placement Information

Staff will be able to open home Records and see where there are matches or mismatches to a child's needs

They can see all available pertinent information from SHINES, including:

Capacity, Current Placements, Distance to Relatives, Home Interests, and Contact information for the Agency

Data is updated from SHINES and is sent automatically when an update is made in SHINES

1. The search results in this new tool show specific homes / placement options available to place the child

As a result of this new tool, you may be contacted by a DFCS Case Manager or other DFCS staff member who has information about your home and wants to confirm the information with you. This may be a change to the previous process in which the DFCS team member would call you to determine if you had capacity without any information available to them.

- 2. There is a new version of the Universal Application
- 3. NO Changes to DFCS Policy on who to contact, when to contact, where to search, Waivers, etc.
- 4. Please continue to follow current processes you have to maintain your facilities
