



Connected Caregivers: Talking to Teens About Sex & Relationships



Sex and relationships are an important part of adolescent development and can influence youth outcomes. In order to make healthy and responsible decisions, young people need support from the adults in their lives. However, adults and caregivers frequently feel ill prepared to initiate these conversations. Some adults and caregivers are afraid they will share too much or not enough, while others believe if they give information children will experiment prematurely. The good news for foster parents, caregivers, and case managers is that there is a lot you can do to positively influence adolescents' decisions about these topics.

Georgia's Personal Responsibility Education Program (GA-PREP) is pleased to host a series of 2-day trainings designed to help adults become a "Connected Caregiver". These trainings have been designed specifically for foster parents, CCI and CPA caregivers, and case managers. Through funding from the DHS/DFCS PREP program, these trainings are being offered for **FREE** for up to 50 attendees (per training date).
