



# Georgia SHINES Release 13.1

## System changes include:

### GTID Validation – New Informational Message

- Added an informational message on the Person Identifiers page when a GTID has not been validated for child with an in-DFCS legal status
- Added informational message on the Education List page when no GTID exist or has been validated for a child with an in-DFCS legal status

### S.A.F.E.: Home Information

- User was not able to save and submit changes on the Home Information page on homes that were in Approved (Full) Active status. For example, the capacity for the home increased, user attempted to increase the capacity on the Home Information page, clicked 'Save and Submit' and the user would receive an error message.
- Users are now able save and submit the Home Information page when changes are made, if the resource's status was previously Approved (Full) Active.

### Placement Information: ICPC Relative

- The "Select Resource" button displays whenever ICPC Relative Placement type is selected. The corresponding error messages for this placement type have been relaxed.
- The question "It was indicated that the child is not placed with a relative. Why was a relative home not selected? What efforts are being made to place the child in a relative home?" will not display for ICPC Relative placements.

### Provider Portal: Case Details – Current Placement Section

- A new field – "Date Placement Entered in SHINES" – displays in the Current Placement section of the Case Details module in SHINES Portal. This date is the date the placement event occurred in Georgia SHINES.

### Portal 2.0: Security Questions Not Alternating

- When a user clicks on "Forgot Password" hyperlink and enters their registered email address in the Password Reset page, the security questions alternate.

### Foster care Case Plan: Current Review Date is Blank (Frontend and DB)

- Corrected logic in the code to allow the Current Review Date to be pulled from the initial Case Plan approval date. This only applies to Initial Review case plans.
