

Coaching for College Completion (CCC)!

What is CCC?

Unique opportunity with individualized resources and support to help college-bound high school seniors and college students achieve the success they desire!

All services are free to the student and include executive-level life **coaching**, additional higher education **academic advisement** and **ongoing advocacy**. Think about it: **successful athletes have sports coaches who support and motivate them**, help them stay on track, bring out the best in them, and identify obstacles early on to overcome them. CCC offers **you** a professional life coach to provide similar wraparound services to prepare you to attain your educational and life goals.

Why CCC?

Orange Duffel Bag's models of coaching young adults have helped program graduates improve their individual outcomes as well as define and execute their game plan for education and life. CCC continues that philosophy and encourages eligible students to stay on track for education success.

Who is CCC?

The CCC team consists of a professional executive-level life coaches, advocates, speakers, and career readiness professionals.

What will the student achieve by participating?

Each participating student will receive connection to resources to assist them with; academic advisement; and self-directed education and career plans. They will also connect with college peers and attend classes with meals included.

Students who successfully complete the program will receive a \$200 scholarship check.

How are college students selected?

Students are nominated or can personally request to be considered for this exciting and specialized program.

What is the cost to the student?

There is no cost to the student. The project and all offered services are free.

What is expected of the students participating?

Students will be required to:

- Fill out an application and agree to participate in the pilot project, and attend a minimum number of coaching sessions/classes
- Agree to be surveyed and interviewed at the end of the project. The interviews will allow participating students to share their perspective, individual results, and offer suggestions for changes or improvements. Each student's privacy will be respected.
- All ODB Coaching projects are independently evaluated. The ODB is a 501c3 charity, nonprofit, whose purpose is to provide coaching and advocacy to young adults and to connect them with resources to help further their education and life plans and stay on track towards success.

How many students can participate?

Each CCC class is limited to 25-30 students.

Space is limited, so students are encouraged to send in their applications ASAP.
