

General Trends Identified by OPM

- Inadequate Supervision leading to an increase in CPS investigations

- Police Interventions have increased with runaways and as behavior mgmt.
- Poor Staff Hiring decisions
- Inadequate Staffing ratios
- Non-timely/Inaccurate Significant Event Reporting
- Poor Physical Plant






Risk Management New Actions
