The Georgia TeenWork Internship Program provides Job Readiness Trainings to foster youth, ages 15 – 18, and additional internship opportunities to foster youth ages, 16-18 to support them as they prepare for self-sufficiency and transition into young adulthood. To ensure youth are prepared for their employment this year, it is now MANDATORY for all youth interested in applying for a position with the Georgia TeenWork Internship Program to attend at least one Job Readiness Training. Along with youth attending, youth supporters (providers, foster parents and caregivers) of youth participants must attend the Job Readiness training as well. 2. Must be between the ages of 15-18 years old
3. Must reside in the state of Georgia
4. Must obtain a State Issued Identification Card (State ID or Driver’s License)
